There was a woman from Freedom whose mother took her own life. She had been struggling with deep depression, carrying the weight of her mother's death and wrestling with self-forgiveness. She came forward for prayer and was deeply impacted by one of our leaders' testimonies. Through that moment, Freedom helped her begin to forgive herself and start releasing the grief and guilt she had been carrying.

Church Alive College has shown me what it truly means to create vision as a husband leading his family and how to cast vision effectively within the ministries I serve. Church Alive College has also taught me how to meet people where they are—whether discussing topics like abortion, ethics, LGBTQ issues, or other sensitive conversations. It has built a strong foundation on how to navigate these moments with truth, grace, and wisdom. In a world filled with confusion and shifting values, Church Alive College has equipped me with the tools, resources, and biblical grounding to stand firm in my faith.

THRIVE

The story I wanted to share came out of one of our 12 p.m. Thrive services, in which, during one of our breakout sessions, we had a miracle happen right before our eyes. The team was going through the SOAP method of breaking down Romans 8:28 when one of the young women started to ask questions about Jesus Christ and the Bible. We proceeded to ask her if she wanted to surrender her life to Christ Jesus, confessing that she was a sinner in need of the Savior, Jesus Christ. Well, the team led her through prayer, and right in front of our eyes, she surrendered her life to Jesus Christ. Glory to God—the greatest miracle. Amen!

A STORY OF IMPACT:

God has worked greatly through Fearless in my life. I went from having extreme social anxiety and no true friends to those chains being broken through having a true community at Fearless that welcomed me and allowed me to truly be myself. Being able to be myself also broke the chains of idolization of the opinions of others. Fearless has blessed me with a spiritual family when I didn't even have true friends. God has used me this year through Fearless by helping me go from being the person needing to be welcomed to the person welcoming new students through the Connect Team, even giving my first word of encouragement recently. I have grown so much in my relationship with God, especially through God speaking to me at Fearless, breaking chains through it, and me starting to serve for the first time at Fearless, which has grown into me taking any opportunity possible to serve.



KIDS ALIVE



A STORY OF IMPACT:

One of our Lyndhurst Location kiddos first started coming during Kids Alive Camp and initially struggled to participate with the group, often running out of the room and getting easily distracted. After sharing that he has ADD, we were able to work with him one-on-one, praying together and speaking truth over him: "You haven't been given a spirit of fear. God gave you power, love, and self-control." From that point on, we continued praying with him, and we've seen remarkable growth. He is learning the Bible, the fruit of the Spirit, and how to pray, even helping lead worship with the group, lifting his hands, encouraging others, and praying for self-control over the room. Recently, when he was upset after a nightmare, he chose to pray on his own, asking Jesus to help him, and he has begun applying simple lessons about God's Word and faith in his life.

His family has noticed changes too, including a desire for Christian music at home. Watching him grow from struggling to participate to choosing prayer, leading worship, and practicing self-control has been a beautiful reminder of how gently and powerfully the Holy Spirit works in the life of our kids!

At 252 The Weekend, we had one of the men on the verge of committing suicide right before he registered at the last minute for 252 The Weekend. Specifically, during the burning of the burdens he felt the release of wanting to commit suicide and felt a complete healing come over his entire body. A massive turning point in this man's life.

TRANSFORM DIVORCE CARE

Without a group like this, I can see how many might walk away from the faith, feeling like failures and believing they can't continue their walk with Christ. DivorceCare creates a safe, grace-filled space where we can heal while holding onto our faith.

It was also encouraging to have men in the group, because hearing their perspectives is an important part of the healing process. Through this group, I no longer feel alone. As a Christian woman, I carried a deep sense of failure. I fasted and prayed, and unlike many testimonies I hear in church, my marriage did not get restored; instead, it ended a couple of years ago. That was painful to accept.

But through this support group and the DivorceCare study, I was constantly reminded that I am a child of God, that He cherishes me, and that He still has a plan for my life. Now I have the tools, the encouragement, and the knowledge to continue this journey with confidence and faith in Christ.

RESILIENT WOMAN

The night before RW, I prayed for the sponsorship to be granted because I really wanted to attend, even if I had to go alone. I started to become discouraged on Thursday because it was 12 p.m., and I still didn't hear back. I thought to myself, "That's okay. Maybe it's just not where I'm supposed to be at the moment." Around 2 p.m., I received an email saying the sponsorship was granted, and I was so happy and appreciative. I immediately started to get ready.

I believe that God moved mountains for me to attend, and I'm so thankful that He did. It was my first women's conference and definitely won't be my last. I needed to go not only to build a stronger relationship with Him, but also to create my sisterhood.

Thank you so much for the opportunity to attend RW. More importantly, thank You, Lord, for always being there for me, for listening to my cries, and for loving me. All the glory to You!

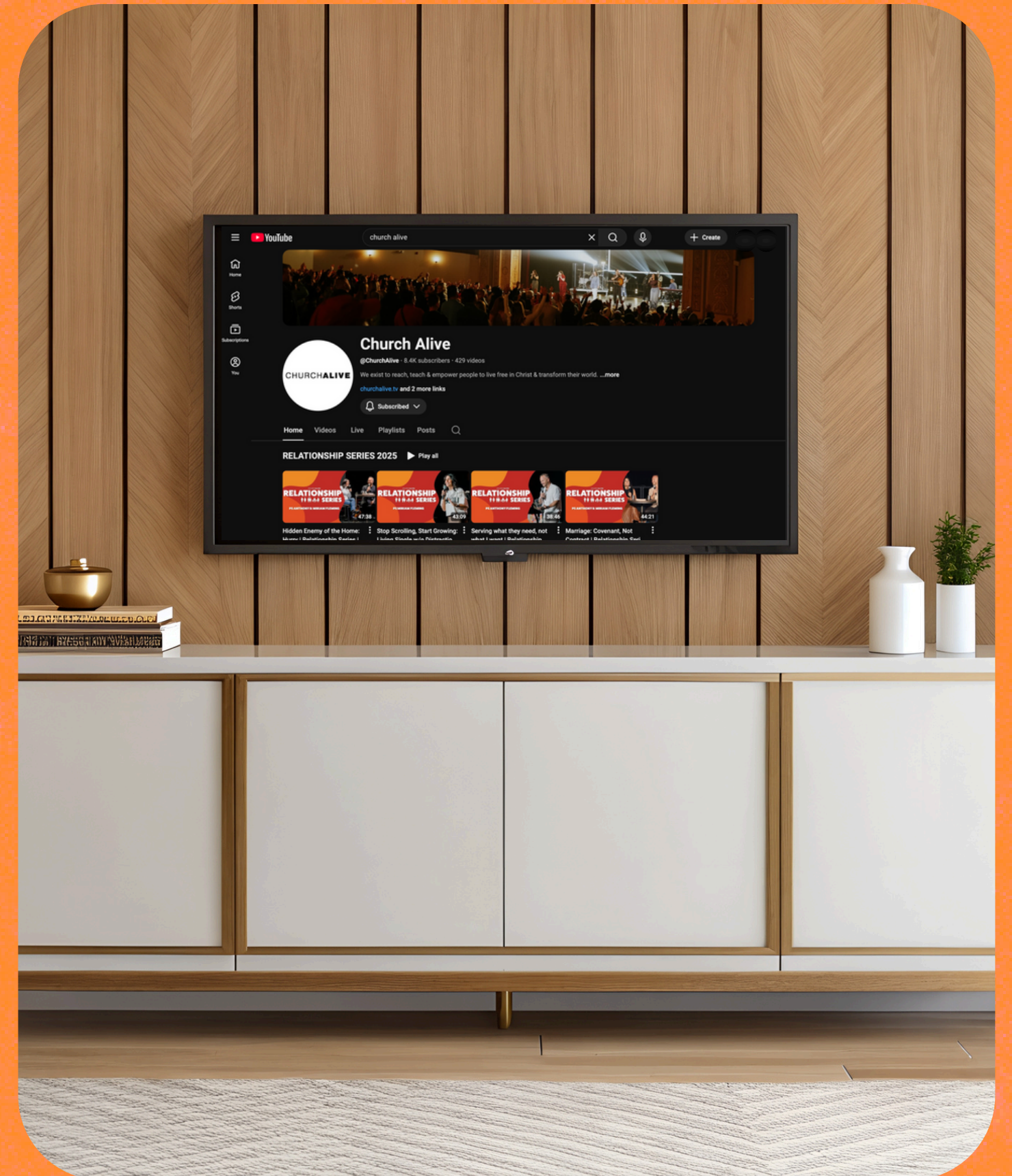

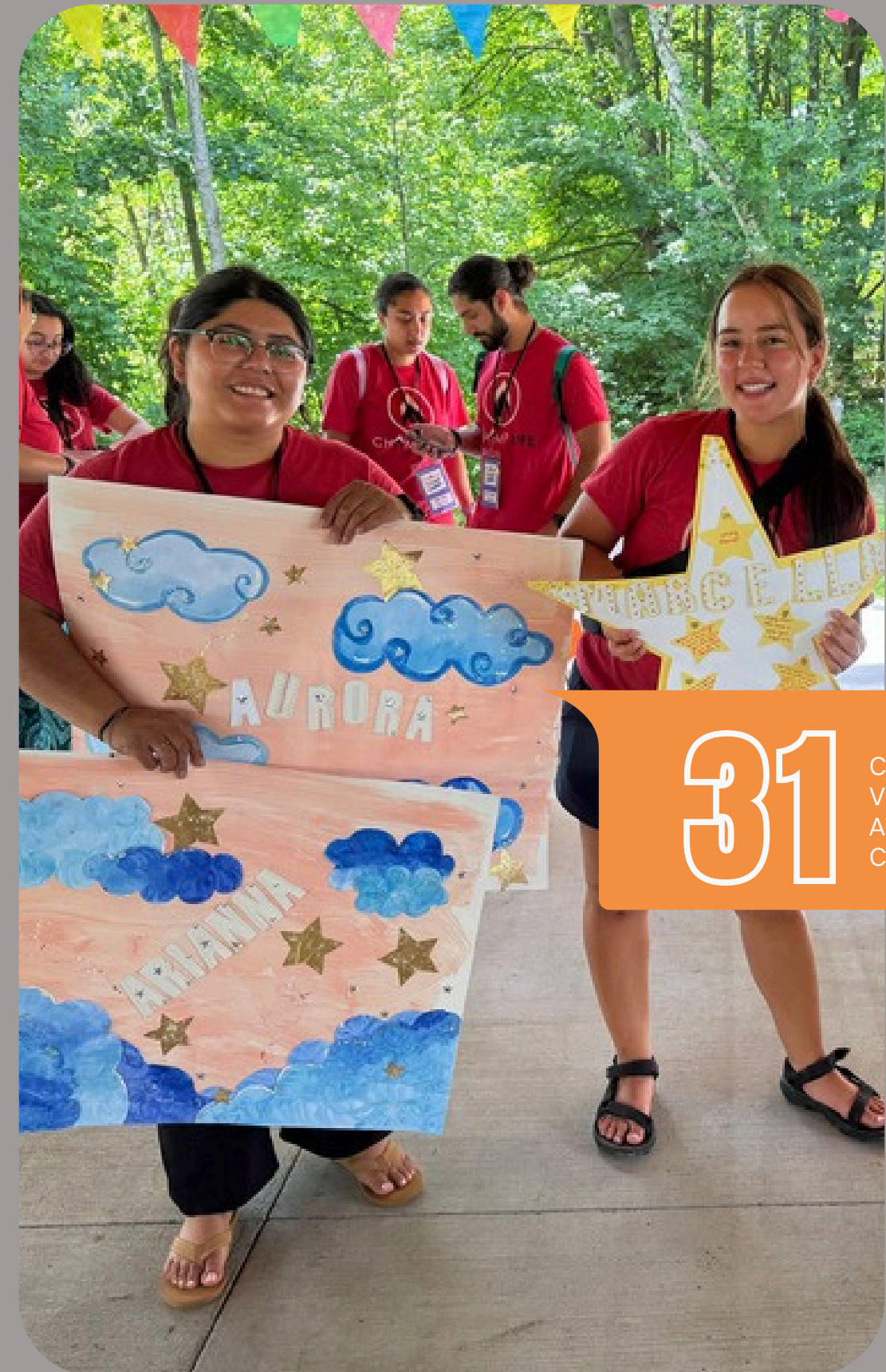

GIVING CHRISTMAS AWAY

Giving Christmas Away is our church's annual opportunity to shift the focus of the season from receiving to serving, and this year, generosity translated into measurable impact! Because of the faithfulness of our church family, we were able to provide 210 ShopRite gift cards to help local families with groceries, deliver 15 family boxes to households in need, give away 197 coats to the unhoused, and bless 250 foster children through CASA with Christmas gifts. In addition to meeting practical needs, we partnered with trusted global ministries—including Legacy Refuge and Love N Care Ministries—to extend hope beyond our walls. Giving Christmas Away reflects the heart of Jesus—generous, compassionate, and outward-focused—and demonstrates that generosity is not just something we do during a season, but who we are as a church.
